Assembly at Pergamum

Reading from Rev 2:12-17

Re 2:12 ¶ And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

Aesculapius

Destination

- PERGAMOS means marriage Pontifix Maximus Constantine took this title first -pontifex literally means "bridge-builder" (pons + facere); "maximus" literally means "greatest".
- It was an illustrious city of wealth, fashion, and mystery, renowned for its learning, its refinement, its medicine and science.
- It boasted a library of some 200,000 volumes, second only in the world to the great library of Alexandria.
- 4. It was the Cathedral City of Paganism, where Temples,
 - Universities, and Palaces of Paganism abounded. There were temples to Juno, Jupiter, Venus, Bacchus, and Aesculapius.
- 5. Here, first, in Asia, was set up the worship of the Emperor as God. The image of Caesar was venerated with the burning of incense. Here too, was the residence of the pagan Roman Viceroy. In a word, the Throne of Satan was there in Pergamos.

3 times there is a mention of this sword Rev 1:16, Rev 19:15, 21 and Rev 2:12 – this is Associated with his mouth indicative of Penetrative and executive power of his mouth


- Until the first century this city was the capital of the province of Asia.
 From 133 BC King Attalus III ceded the kingdom to Rome for protection from Syria.
- The city was the centre of administration for the whole of the province and the symbol of power was the sword.
- The proconsul as the chief magistrate had the right of passing death penalty without any recourse to higher authority.
- 5) This in the Roman empire was know as the "Right of the Sword"

Re 2:13 and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.

Some truths about Antipas

- 1) Personal Devotion -He held the name of Christ Vs Caesar – scriptural revelation of Christ
- Severe testing of his/their faith hast not denied my faith
- 3) Faithful tradition says that he was a dentist and refused to burn incense to Caesar.
- 4) Martyr the same word has been translated witness. Rev 1:5 - Re 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead
- 5) Public killing By the order of the magistrate he was killed along side or before the other believers
- 6) History he was enclosed in a brazen bull which was made red hot during the days of Domitian 81-96

Condemnation

Re 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. **Re 2:15** So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.

- 1. Balaam Num 25
 - There were those who held the doctrine of Balaam to dilute the value of separation
 - Error of Balaam Jude 11 to imagine that God change his mind and curse Israel
 - 2 Pet 2:15 way of Balaam to sell prophetic gifts for money
 - Deeds of the Nicolaitans have become the doctrine of Nicolaitans-Nico-, combinatory form of nīkē, "victory" in Greek, and laos means people, or more specifically, the laity; hence, the word may be taken to mean "lay conquerors" or "conquerors of the lay people".

Exhortation

Re 2:16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

Re 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the **hidden manna**, and will give him a **white stone**, and in the stone a **new name** written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.

- Repent μετανοεω metanoeo complete change of mind
- Hidden manna knowledge of the life and person of Christ the 30 years of obsecurity
- White stone
 - Voting pebble white stone for acquittal and black for condemnation
 - The honour of getting admission into a wealthy home
 - Victor in the games would get a white stone with his name written
